Youth Leader's in Action

The *Youth Leaders in Action (YLIA)* program is a new summer volunteer program that places teens in work environments within Coconino County departments.

YLIA participants will be immersed in work environments and attend leadership workshops where they will identify and implement leadership skills.

The *YLIA* program concludes with a 1-day Leadership Presentation Day planned by youth to showcase their leadership skills. These upcoming leaders will gain insights into county government and a potential career pathway within Coconino County.

Department Qualifications

- ◆ Provide mentorship to a YLIA youth for 3-weeks in your department on Tuesday and Wednesday each week.
- ◆ Provide direction and leadership during YLIA work day.
- ◆ Provide a YLIA project that will engage the youth into your work.
- ◆ Session 1 - June 11 - 28, 2018
Session 2 - July 9 - 26, 2018
- ◆ Attend Graduation of your YLIA participant on 6/28/18 or 7/26/18.

- ◆ Department orientations to be held May and June, dates TBD.
- ◆ Teen/Parent Orientation will be held week prior to session 1 or 2.
- ◆ Graduation: June 28 and July 26

- ◆ 16-18 years old.
- ◆ Available Monday thru Thursday during selected session.
- ◆ Session 1: June 11 - 28, 2018
Session 2 : July 9 - 26, 2018
- ◆ Have available transportation to and from work site .
- ◆ Strong work ethic with a good attitude and willingness to learn.
- ◆ Available the entire three weeks of the selected program session.
