The Indian Education Office will start accepting Navajo School Clothing Program (NSCP) order forms on Monday, July 21, 2014.

The Navajo School Clothing Program and PUSD Indian Education Office would like to encourage parents/guardians to adhere to the following procedure:

Eligibility Criteria and Requirements:

- ✓ The NSCP order forms can only be obtained at “**B**” **Building the Educational Services Office** at 500 South Navajo Drive next to PUSD District Office. We are given a limited number of NSCP order forms once all of the forms have been given out they are *gone*. *First Come, First Serve!* The four schools (Desert View, Lake View, Page Middle and Page High School) offices will NOT give out any NSCP order forms.
- ✓ Your child has to be 3 to 13 years of age. *NO EXCEPTION.*
- ✓ First preference will be given to students on FREE and REDUCED lunch program due limited NSCP order forms.
- ✓ The parent/guardian MUST accurately provide and complete seven (7) of the required information listed below: *(if the order form is submitted incomplete your child will not be eligible for clothing assistance.)*
 1. Student's Census number
 2. Student's Date of Birth
 3. Parent signature
 4. Both of parent's census numbers if married and if single parent the primary guardian.
 5. Mailing address and telephone number
 6. Clothing size *(Please bring your child's height, clothing measurements and size)*
 7. Chapter Affiliation

Your child's Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB) must be on file with Indian Education office.

➤ There will be ONLY (1) **DEADLINE** for submission of NSCP Order Forms
ALL due Friday, August 22, 2014 at 4:00 pm (MST)

➤ **NO EXCEPTION** ➤

Indian Education Office will make arrangements to pick up the clothing and distribute to the surrounding five chapter houses (Gap, Coppermine, Inscription House, Kaibeto and LeChee) when it is packaged by NSCP Office.

PARENTAL COST ASSISTANCE

Criteria for Johnson O'Malley (JOM) Financial Assistance

A parent or guardian requesting financial assistance for their child must meet with PUSD Indian Education Director, Mrs. Elouise Goatson prior to receiving service.

The objective for the preliminary meeting is to assess the need and determine the eligibility of requestor.

The student should meet the following Eligibility Criteria and Requirements:

- ✓ Student's Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB) is on file with PUSD Indian Education Office.
- ✓ Student is eligible for Free or Reduced Lunch program.
- ✓ Parent and student must personally come to the Indian Education Office to apply for assistance.
- ✓ Complete the provided "Parental Cost Form"
- ✓ The student needs to bring a list of school supplies for their classes provided by his or her teacher(s).
- ✓ Student needs to write a "Thank you" letter for their supplies. The letter must be given to the Indian Education Office before the supplies leave the premise.
