Coconino County Community Services is implementing a new bus pass policy for residents who are actively working with a case manager and looking for employment. Attached is a referral form for the case worker to fill out for the client stating how many day bus passes the client needs (up to 3 bus passes per referral form) to search for work. A Case worker can provide up to two referrals per client for a total of 6 day bus passes. The referral form is to be given to the client to bring to Community Services and be provided the bus passes.

The rest of our bus pass policy still stand as is for medical appointments and job interviews. Residents can come to Community Services and provide their appointment card or documentation of a job interview and they will receive a one day bus pass. We look forward to serving the residents of Coconino County in a much more meaningful way.
