What You Need to Bring:

- * Government picture ID for taxpayer (and spouse)
- * Original Social Security or ITIN cards for all household members
- * Proof of income, including ALL W2's and 1099 forms
- * All other important tax documents, including 1098 (Tuition), 1095 (Health Care), etc.
- * Name, address and tax ID# of child care provider and amount of money paid
- * Account and routing numbers for direct deposit, in writing preferred
- * Copy of last year's tax return (Helpful but not required except for those who itemized deductions last year)
- * If filing jointly, both adults must be present to sign the return

The IRS identifies a small number of returns that we cannot prepare. They include married filing separately and some self-employment (Schedule C) returns, among others. Please call with any questions about the scope of returns we can do.
