

Music Students Will Represent Flagstaff In the All State Band


Two FUSD high school students have accomplished a rare feat and have been accepted into all three Arizona honor bands. Bryan Colvard is a senior at Coconino High School who plays the trombone, and Mikhaila Rosanova is a junior at Flagstaff High School who plays the trumpet. After high school students from across the state auditioned, both Bryan and Mikhaila were accepted in the Arizona All State Jazz Ensemble, the Northern Arizona Region Honor Orchestra, and the Arizona All State Concert Band. The two students will be traveling to Tucson to rehearse for three days and perform with the All State Band on April 21st.

Bryan Colvard has been studying trombone with Dr. Vining from Northern Arizona University for the past two years. Bryan has also learned that he has been awarded \$120,000 (\$30K a year) to play trombone at California Lutheran University where he will be attending this fall.

Mikhaila Rosanova, who has also accomplished the same feats, studies privately with Mr. Colvard and participates in the FHS Concert Band, FHS Choir, FHS Acapella Club, and the FHS Drama Club.

Through persistent work and dedication, Bryan and Mikhaila have accomplished what most would consider rare for high school music students.
