ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Commodity Senior Food Program (CSFP) is a federally funded food distribution program that is designed to improve health with nutritious USDA foods.

Benefits of this program include a once per month **food package** for clients, **nutrition education**, and a **reduction in malnutrition** affecting seniors.

Services are offered in Cochise, Coconino, Gila, La Paz, Maricopa, Mojave, Pima, Pinal, Santa Cruz, Yavapai, Navajo, Apache, and Yuma counties.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Participants must:

- Be 60 years of age or older (must show photo ID and proof of residency to apply)
- Meet the annual household income requirements:
