Who does ACASI serve?

ACASI provides services to children and adolescents who have been impacted by the following types of intimate partner violence:

- Intimate Partner Homicide-Murder of a parent or caregiver by a current or former partner
- Near Fatality-Attempted murder of a parent or caregiver by a current or former intimate partner
- Familial Homicide-Murder of a family member by another family member resulting from intimate partner violence
- Sexual Competitor Homicide-Murder of a parent or caregiver's current partner by their former partner or vice versa
- Suicide-Completion of suicide by a child's parent or caregiver in response to experiencing intimate partner violence

Our Services

- Intensive case management
- Mentoring
- Trauma therapy
- Support groups
- Personal advocacy
- Assistance with Victims' Compensation and Victims' Rights
- Court accompaniment and navigation

Unique ACASI Services

Volunteer Mentor Program

Volunteers provide one-on-one mentoring to help children and adolescents build resiliency.

Home Visits

ACASI team members travel directly to families' homes across the state of Arizona to ensure services are as accessible as possible.

The Healing Lands Project

Offers opportunities for peer support through therapeutic outdoor adventures.

Telehealth Services
